<b>Job Title</b>	<b><i>Nautical Superintendent</i></b>
<b>(Sub) Section</b>	Section Marine Operations
<b>Performance areas of the (Sub) Section</b>	Ensuring the safe, efficient, reliable and environmentally responsible delivery of marine services in the Port of Fujairah
<b>Power of Decision</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The Nautical Superintendent is responsible for the performance areas of the Nautical Superintendent</li> <li>- The Nautical Superintendent reports to the Head of Section Marine Operations.</li> </ul>

Performance Areas of the Function	
<b>Management</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ensures the proper condition and functioning of the nautical, navigational, deck, lifesaving and firefighting equipment, lines and coating system on board of the Marine Craft in the Marine Departments Care.</li> <li>- Designs the maintenance schedule for the equipment, lines and coating systems in his care and ensures that this schedule is carried out properly by the crews of the Marine Craft.</li> <li>- Ensures that the equipment under his supervision is properly and validly certified.</li> <li>- Ensures the compliance with and adherence to the ISM Procedures on board of certified Marine Craft in his care.</li> <li>- Advises the Head of Section Marine Operations on issues with or possible improvements to the nautical and navigational equipment of Marine Craft in his care.</li> </ul>
<b>Maintenance &amp; Repair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Ensures that the Nautical/Navigational equipment and lines of the marine craft assigned to him are kept at the desired level of maintenance.</li> <li>- Identifies issues with maintenance and repair of nautical/navigational equipment and lines on board the assigned Marine Craft and advises the Head of Section Marine Operations accordingly.</li> </ul>
